keyboard	The alphabet as push keys

mouse	A small piece of technology used to move around the screen
touchpad	Works like a mouse but with a finger
Right click	Accept and action a command
Left click	Select an object or item
technology	Hardware and software
Double-click	Press the button on a mouse or touchpad twice quickly.
typing	Pressing button to 'write' on the computer screen.
