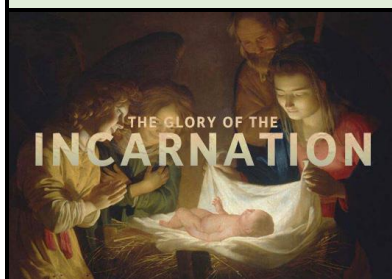


What should I already know?

Messiah	The promised deliverer of the Jewish nation prophesied in the Hebrew Bible. Jesus regarded by Christians as the Messiah of the Hebrew prophecies and the saviour of humankind
Incarnation	In Christian theology: the embodiment of God the Son in human flesh as Jesus Christ.
Gospel	The teaching or revelation of Christ.
Theological terms	Terms based on God's revelations.
