Allah's words given directly to Muhammad. Gives guidance on how Muslims can live their lives on the right path.

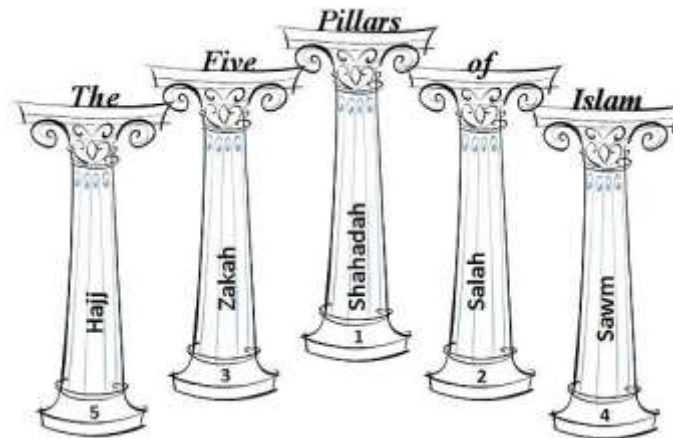
Prophet
