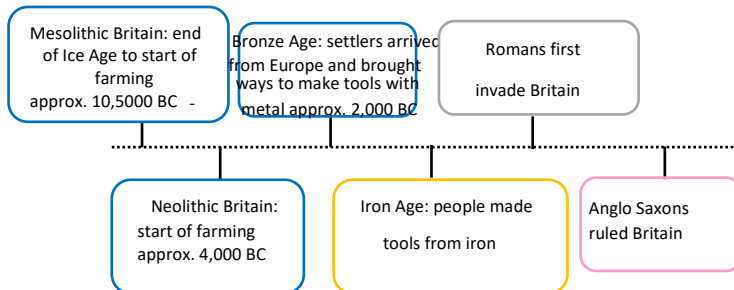
Topic: Viking Raids and Invasion

What should I already know?

- The Stone Age was when early humans used tools from stone. This lasted until the Bronze Age.
- The Bronze Age began when **settlers** arrived from Europe to Britain. These **settlers** brought with them ways of making tools from metal (bronze).
- The Iron Age lasted from 800 BC till the Roman **invasion** (AD 43) - this was when people used tools made from iron.
- In AD 43, the Romans under the order of Emperor Claudius, first **invaded** Britain and Roman rule lasted until AD 410.
- That the Anglo Saxons ruled from 449 AD to 1066 AD.

Viking migration

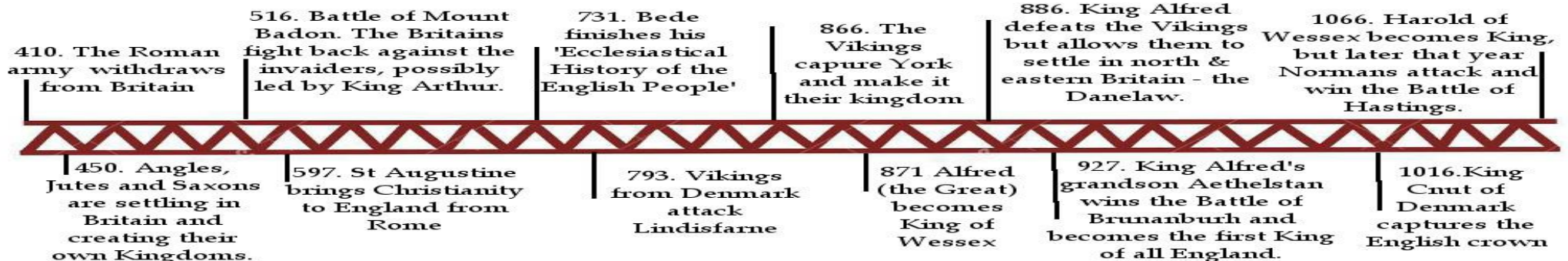


Vocabulary

Berserker	A group of elite Viking warriors who went into battle without traditional armour
Colonise	Settlers establish control over an area.
Conquer	A ship that can carry at least 60 men.
Danegeld	A tax raised to pay to the Vikings in order to save land from being ravaged.
Descendants	Off spring of a particular person.
Figurehead	A carved wooden dragon or snake head at the front end of a Viking long ship used to scare enemies.
Longship	A boat that holds over 60 men.
merchant	A person or company involved in wholesale trade, especially one dealing with foreign countries or supplying goods to a particular trade.
seafaring	A person regularly travelling by sea.
Viking	Any of the Scandinavian seafaring pirates and traders who raided and settled in many parts of north-western Europe in the 8th–11th centuries.
