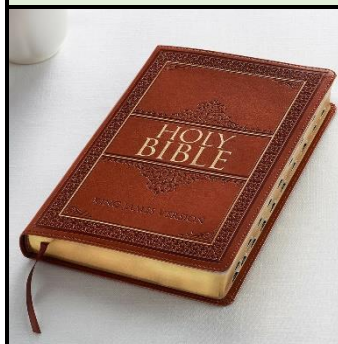
What should I already know?

Vocabulary

Christians	A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity.
Gospel	The teaching or revelation of Christ.
Instructions	A direction or order.
Clergy	A body of ordained ministers in a Christian church
Leper	A person who is rejected by others for moral or social reasons.

What will I know by the end of this unit?

I can identify this question as part of a 'Gospel', which tells the story of the life and teaching of Jesus.

I can make clear links between the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus and be 'fishers of people'.

I can offer suggestions about what Jesus' actions towards the leper might mean for a Christian.

I can make simple links between Bible texts and the concept of 'Gospel' (good news).

I can give examples of how Christians try to show love to all, including how members of the clergy follow Jesus' teaching.
