What should I already know?

- Pupils will know that Christians believe that through his teachings Jesus challenges everyone about the way they live.
- Pupils will know that it is claimed that Jesus could heal a leper. By doing this Christians believe that showed love for those that others ignore.
- Pupils can retell the parable of the Good Samaritan (including the man being attacked, the Levite and the priest passing by, the Samaritan stopping to help, and that Jesus asked who was this man's neighbour).

Moral dilemma	a situation in which a difficult choice has to be made between two courses of action			
Justice	the quality of being fair and reasonable.			
Generosity	the quality of being kind and generous.
