Reading

In addition to this, we have dedicated 20 minutes a day to read our class book so we have the time to enjoy our class text together.

It is extremely important that children read regularly at home. Please record this in their reading records, along with any discussions you have had about their book and we look forward to hearing about all the wonderful authors, genres and topics that you have been reading.

Homework

Homework will be sent home every Friday and is expected back by the following Wednesday. Please complete using the homework books provided. Our expectation is that children take ownership of their own learning and therefore hand it back in on time. Our homework includes a reading comprehension and maths questions.

We encourage children to try and complete this over the weekend and then there will be adequate time to support children in school if they become stuck. We also expect homework to be completed to the same standard as classwork and only children with a pen license are permitted to use pen.

If your child wishes to do extra homework, we encourage them to use their Times Tables Rock Stars account. You can find helpful video clips and details of the methods we use for Maths on the school website.

LITERACY


This term, we will be using The Promise by Nicola Davies and the Viewer by Gary Crew.
