How can you help?

We believe that teaching and learning is a three-way relationship between child, school and parent. Revisiting our work at home helps the children to consolidate what we have been learning about, and also enables them to share their learning with you.

Homework in Year 3 consists of:

Homework - Homework will be shared using SEESAW on a Friday and then completed in pink homework books which need to be returned by Wednesday in order for them to be marked and returned by Friday.

Spellings - Children will be given a handwriting sheet to complete in their pink books. A few minutes practice every day will make a huge difference. Discuss the spelling rule, play spelling games, how many times can you write the word correctly in 1 minute, spelling races, rainbow writing, make up mnemonics - anything that helps to get those spellings firmly into the brain! Times tables - Times tables are a major focus for Year 3 and 4. We've invested in a subscription to Times Tables Rock

Stars which is a super-fun way to practise these skills. We test times tables through Froggy Maths weekly.

Reading – reading regularly from a wide range of genres is ex-

tremely important, helping open the children to new ideas and knowledge, supporting their imagination and their ability to write well. Children should be reading at home at least three times per week. Please record this in their reading record, along with any comments about the discussions you've had about what they are reading. Our Year 3 Recommended Reads list is a great place to start when looking for books to enjoy and can be found on the school website and consists of different authors and genres - just follow the link below. If children then complete a Book Review of any medium e.g. written or spoken, this will be entered into a draw to win the prize of 'Inspirational Reader' within their class and win a token for the Book Machine.
