Dear Parents,

As we begin the new academic year we wanted to take the opportunity to remind all pupils about the uniform policy we have in place. We always have, and most certainly will continue to pride ourselves on our high standards of school uniform and therefore, adhering to the school uniform policy has always been something we monitor and promote throughout the school.

School Uniform (All clearly labelled)

- ❖ Grey trousers, shorts, a skirt or green checked school dress.
- ❖ A red polo shirt with the school logo on or a plain red polo shirt
- ❖ Green cardigan or jumper with the school logo on or a plain bottle green cardigan / jumper
- ❖ Dark socks, white socks or tights. All of which should be **plain, with no logos and not brightly coloured.**
- ❖ Black, closed-toe, flat shoes that are safe for running and play and easy for children to manage independently
- ❖ Hair bands should be plain and in the school colours of red, green or hair coloured. (No large bows)

PE kit (All clearly labelled)

- ❖ A white t-shirt either plain or with the school logo on
- ❖ Green shorts or plain black tracksuit bottoms or black leggings
- ❖ A green PE hoodie or school jumper / cardigan
- ❖ Plain white or black trainers.

Please note, Nike Pro shorts are not suitable for PE lessons and brightly coloured, neon trainers are not part of our uniform policy.

PE hoodies can **only be worn on PE days**. They must not be worn instead of a school jumper or cardigan on full uniform days. You are under no obligation to purchase a PE Hoodie - a school jumper or cardigan is absolutely fine, yet a pupil choosing to wear a coloured hoodie of their choice **is not** an alternative option. All pupils should come to school dressed in their PE kits, meaning they spend breaktimes and lunchtimes outside in it too.

Earrings should only be worn to school if they are a small plain stud. Previously, we have seen decorative pieces which not only pose as a health and safety hazard but are also against our adopted policy and children have been asked to remove them. Furthermore, it is imperative that earrings must be removed or taped over on PE days.

If we feel your child's uniform is not in line with the uniform policy, then you will be contacted via email to make suitable adjustments.
